

## Clearing cache for PC Chrome

1. Open Google Chrome
2. Click ☰
3. Select **More tools**
4. Click **Clear browsing data...**
5. Click the **Basic** tab.
6. Check the **Cached images and files** box.
7. Click **CLEAR DATA**


Method 1 On Desktop



1 Open Google Chrome . Its app icon resembles a red, yellow, green, and blue sphere.




2 Click ☰. It's in the upper-right corner of the window. A drop-down menu will appear.






**4** Click **Clear browsing data...**. It's in the pop-out menu. This will open the Browsing Data window.


**5** Click the **Basic** tab. This is in the upper-left corner of the Browsing Data window.

- If you want to clear Chrome's website settings cache, click the **Advanced** tab instead.




