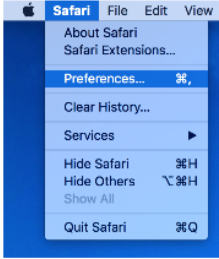


Clearing cache for MAC Safari

Safari 8.0 - 10.0 (Mac) - Clearing Cache and Cookies

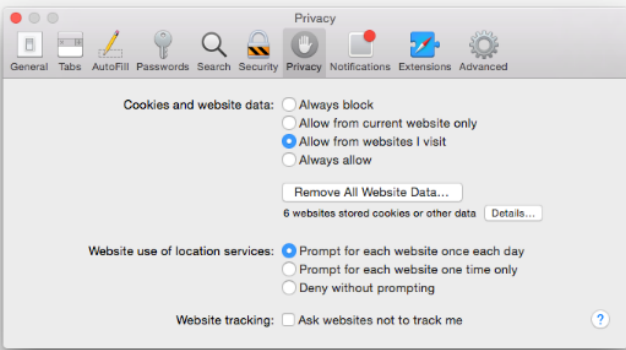
This document explains how to clear cache and cookies in Safari 8.0 to 10.0.

1. Click **Safari** in the upper left hand side of your screen. In the menu that appears, click **Preferences**.



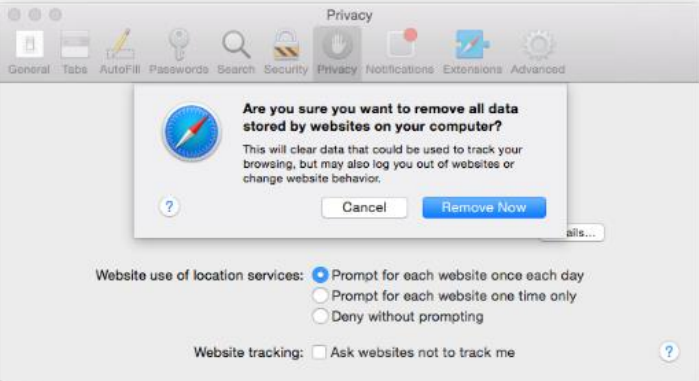
