

## Disabling Pop Up Blockers/ Turning Off Pop Up Blockers for Mac



**NOTE: We do not recommend permanently turning off your blocker.**

Doing so can leave you vulnerable to malicious programs. So either disable the blocker temporarily or add favorite websites to your browser's safe list, so pop-ups will always appear.


#### How to Disable a Pop-Up Blocker: Chrome for Mac

##### Disable a Pop-Up Blocker on a Web Page


If a Web page tries to send you a pop-up when your blocker is turned on, an icon with a red "x" will appear in your address bar.

Clicking the icon will allow you to:

- Always allow pop-ups from this site
- Continue blocking pop-ups
- Manage pop-up blocking









### Disable a Pop-Up Blocker Within Chrome Settings

1. Open Chrome.
2. Click the Chrome menu in the upper right corner.



3. Click **Settings** in the drop-down menu.
