

Disabling Pop Up Blockers/ Turning Off Pop Up Blockers for PC's



NOTE: We do not recommend permanently turning off your blocker.

Doing so can leave you vulnerable to malicious programs. So either disable the blocker temporarily or add favorite websites to your browser's safe list, so pop-ups will always appear.

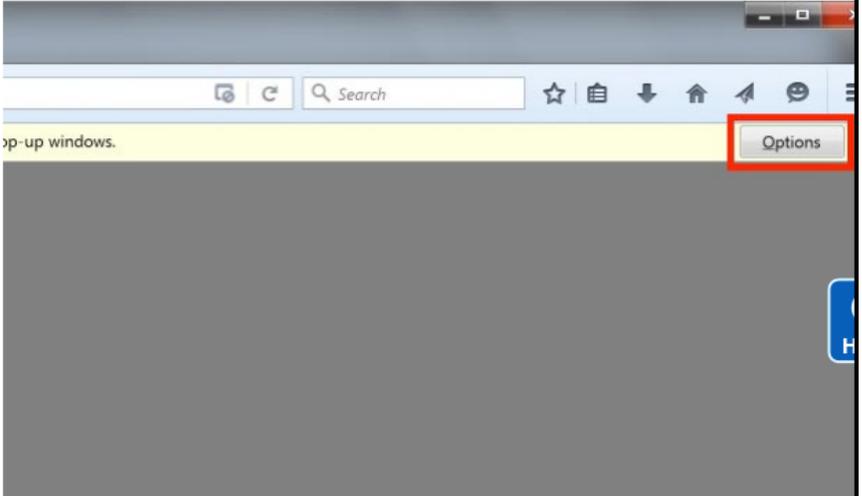

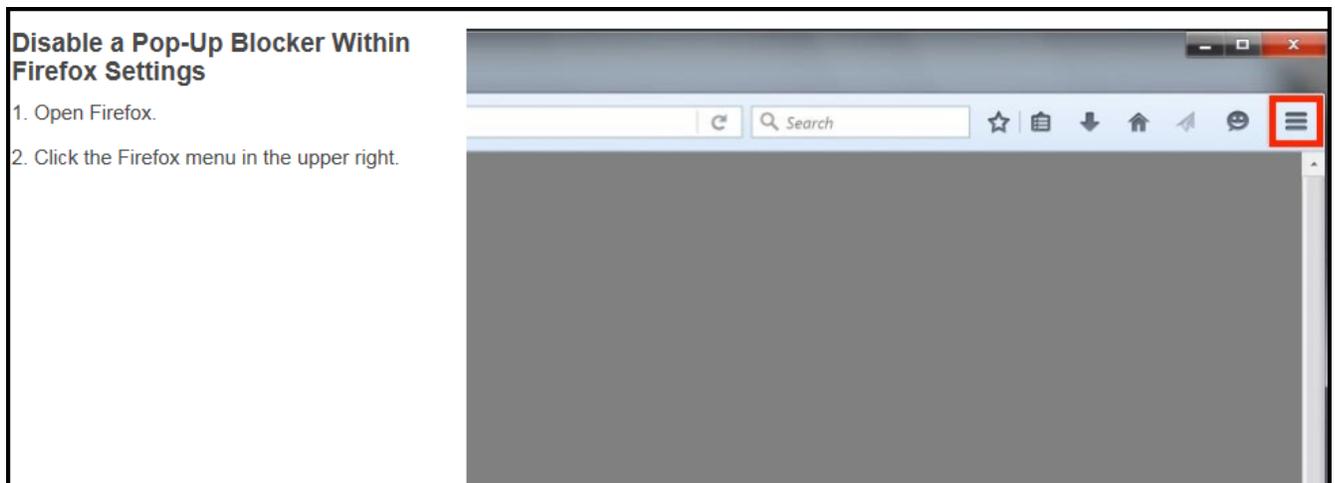
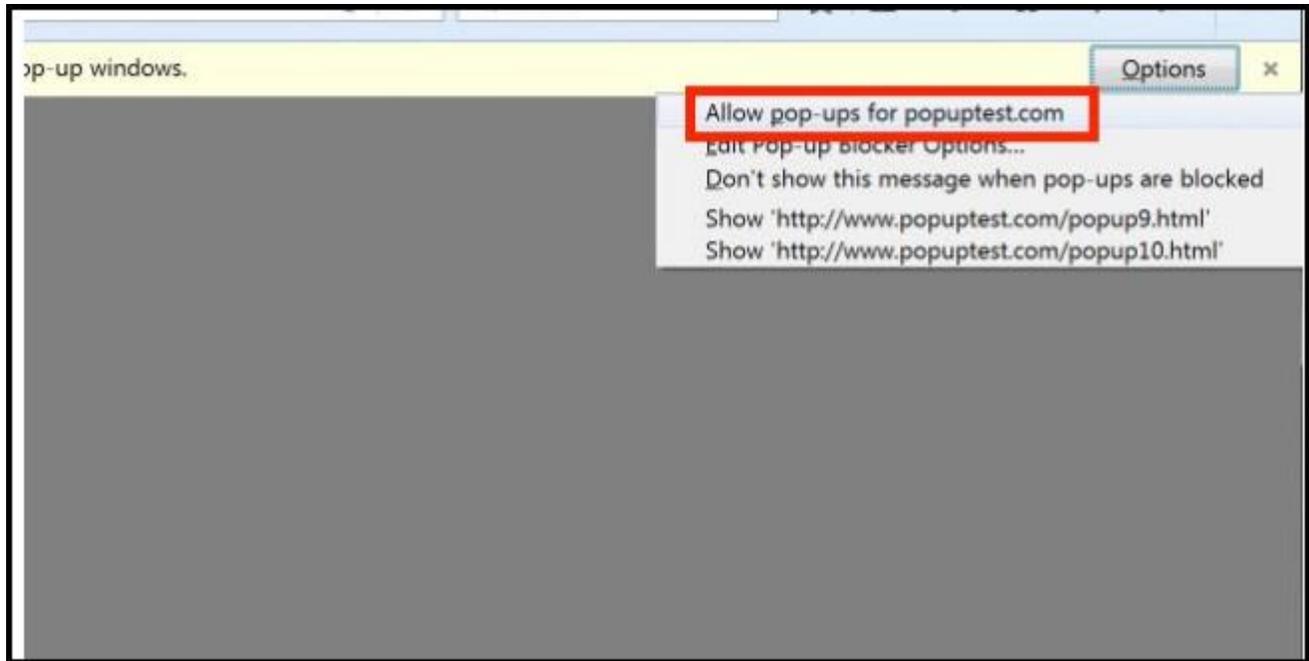
Disable a Pop-Up Blocker on a Web Page

If a Web page tries to send you a pop-up when your blocker is turned on, an information bar will appear at the top of your browser window.

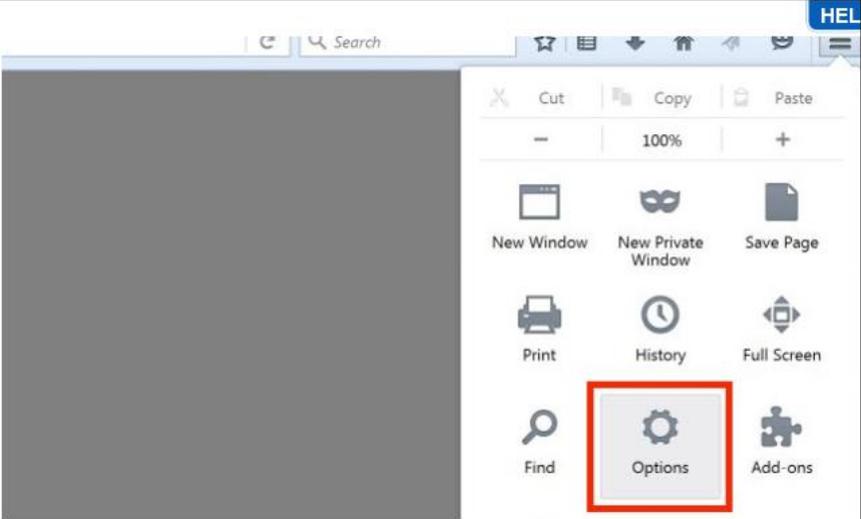
Clicking the **Options** button within the information bar will allow you to:

- Allow pop-ups from this site
- Edit your pop-up blocker options
- Never show an information bar when pop-ups are blocked
- Display the blocked pop-up window

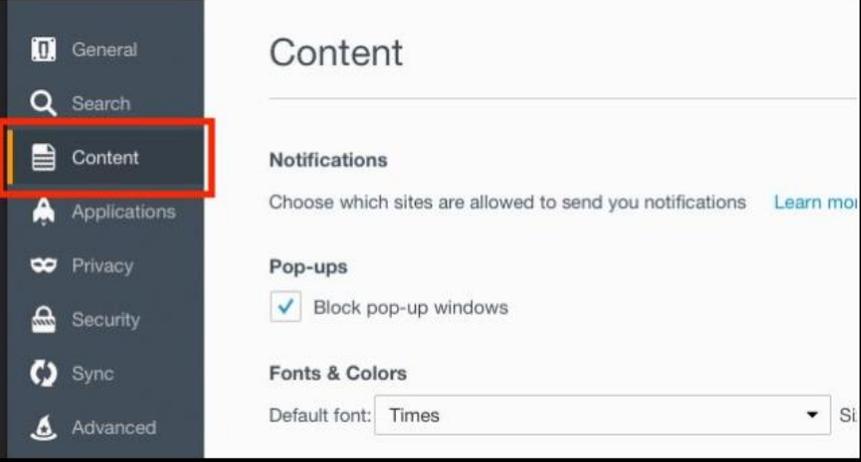




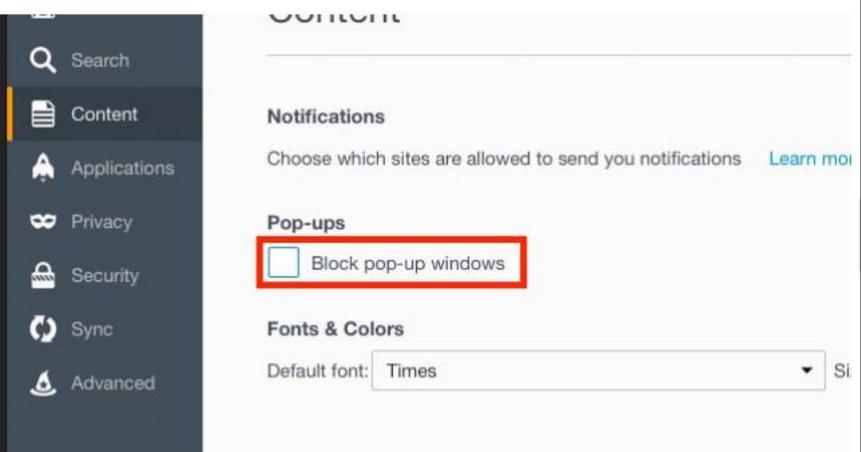
3. Click **Options** in the drop-down menu.



4. In the left-hand navigation, click **Content**.



5. Under **Pop-ups** uncheck **Block pop-up windows**.
