Meeting of the State Employees Pension Benefits Review Committee – The Chairman informed members of the Council that this Committee is composed of members of the Legislature and has Pension Board representation, Pension Office representation and Advisory Council representation. Many pension benefits have flowed from the influence of this Committee over a period of time. Larry Talley, who represents the Council on this Committee, is trying to get the Committee to meet.
