- 3. Continuous funding of OPEB

11. Pension Office:

Director Joanna Adams informed the PAC the State has a benefit committee researching ways for the State to reduce costs for future benefits for all State employees and pensioners. Director Adams disclosed the State's current total liability for the OPEB at \$9.4 Billion and any future PRI,s total cost be approximately \$61 million dollars per 1.0% increase.

Director Adams lastly informed us even during this economic hardship due to the COVID crisis. The Pension Board of Trustees was still able to show a 10.3% increase in the pension fund.
